



Dear Players and Parents,

We are asking you to be extra vigilant in following the [COVID-19 Safety Rules](#) listed below during the **Winter Ball Camp**. We have been in communication with the Health Departments and their concern is that our camp will promote large crowds in one place. We want to be able to continue to play baseball throughout the rest of 2021. So, if you follow the Safety Plan for the sole purpose of being able to continue to play baseball this year, that is sufficient reason enough!

RMSB Safety Plan

- **Spectator Limit:** Limit of 50 persons per field (includes players and camp staff).
- **Social distancing:** Individual households must sit at least 6 feet apart from other parties.
- **Masks:** Required for everyone. Exception: not required during games for those actively participating in games.
- **Healthy Participants Only:** Any players, coaches, or spectators who are sick will not be allowed at games or practices. Coaches must check players for COVID-19 symptoms prior to games. Players who have household members with symptoms must stay home from games. All state COVID-19 guidelines apply.
- **6-feet Apart:** Social distancing rules apply when in lines for the restroom, concessions, and all other times when possible.
- **Sunflower Seeds:** No sunflower seeds allowed in dugouts.
